BUNNY EGG 3D EASTER MACHINE Embroidery design - 4 sizes



HOW TO CREATE, A STEP-BY-STEP PROCESS

You need to know how to sew to embroider and sew this bunny! Use a quilt fabric that doesn't fray at the edges. Hoop the fabric with the stabilizer together in the hoop.



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Embroider every part of the design. We put everything together in the same hoop and embroidered it all at once. You can do it however you want.



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Cut out the details following the outline. There are two thread outlines; the inner one is where you need to sew the parts.

Carefully remove the stabilizer and extra thread.



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We removed the inside thread line too. There were holes left on the fabric from where the needle punctured it. They are easy to see. You will sew the egg details using these holes.



HOW TO CREATE, A STEP-BY-STEP PROCESS

Hoop the fabric and stabilizer into the hoop. The machine will sew the outline. Stop the car. Place a piece of fabric for the ears on this outline. Ours is yellow fabric.




HOW TO CREATE, A STEP-BY-STEP PROCESS

Turn the ears inside out, then iron them. If you want, you can make tucks in the fabric. If necessary, you can cut the bottom of the ears at an angle before sewing them onto the project.



HOW TO CREATE, A STEP-BY-STEP PROCESS

Put the two pieces of egg right side together. Stitch from one side from mark to mark, as shown in the figure. Please note that the muzzle of the hare and the part with its tail will be on opposite sides.



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Make sure you put your ear between the pieces of the eggs. Try it on from different angles to see what works best.




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Use a needle and thread to sew the pieces of fabric together. Start by making tiny stitches by hand.




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After you finish sewing the first two parts, bend one of the parts and attach the third blank to it. Sew from mark to mark.




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When you sew the first and fourth pieces, leave an opening for eversion. Don't forget about the second ear. It must be seen between the first and fourth parts.



HOW TO CREATE, A STEP-BY-STEP PROCESS

Take the egg and turn it so that the inside is facing out. Stuff the inside of the egg with soft toy stuffing. Close the hole where you stuffed it with a hidden seam.



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The rabbit is ready



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
