HOW TO CREATE, A STEP-BY-STEP PROCESS

This napkin is embroidered in the hoop. The stabilizer will remain inside the napkin. You will not need to cut anything and receive the finished product.

Before you start, wash the fabric you will use for the napkin. The instructions for all of our napkins are almost identical, so we offer instructions for the Andalusian napkin.

Follow those instructions, and you will get a beautiful, high-quality product.

HOW TO CREATE, A STEP-BY-STEP PROCESS

STAGE 1

1. You need to take two pieces of tear-away stabilizer. They should be bigger than your hoop. Put the two pieces together, spray temporary adhesive on top of it, and place the fabric on top of the stabilizer. Hoop the stabilizer and fabric together in the hoop.

STAGE 2

2. Place the hoop in the embroidery machine and start embroidering. When the machine has sewn the outline, please stop it. Remove the hoop from the machine.

STAGE 3

3. Spray adhesive on the wrong side of the embroidery and place a piece of fabric over it, i.e., UNDER the hoop, i.e., from the inside. This will be the back of the napkin.

STAGE 4

4. Put the hoop with the fabric back in the machine.
5. Next, embroider another outline in the color of the fabric.

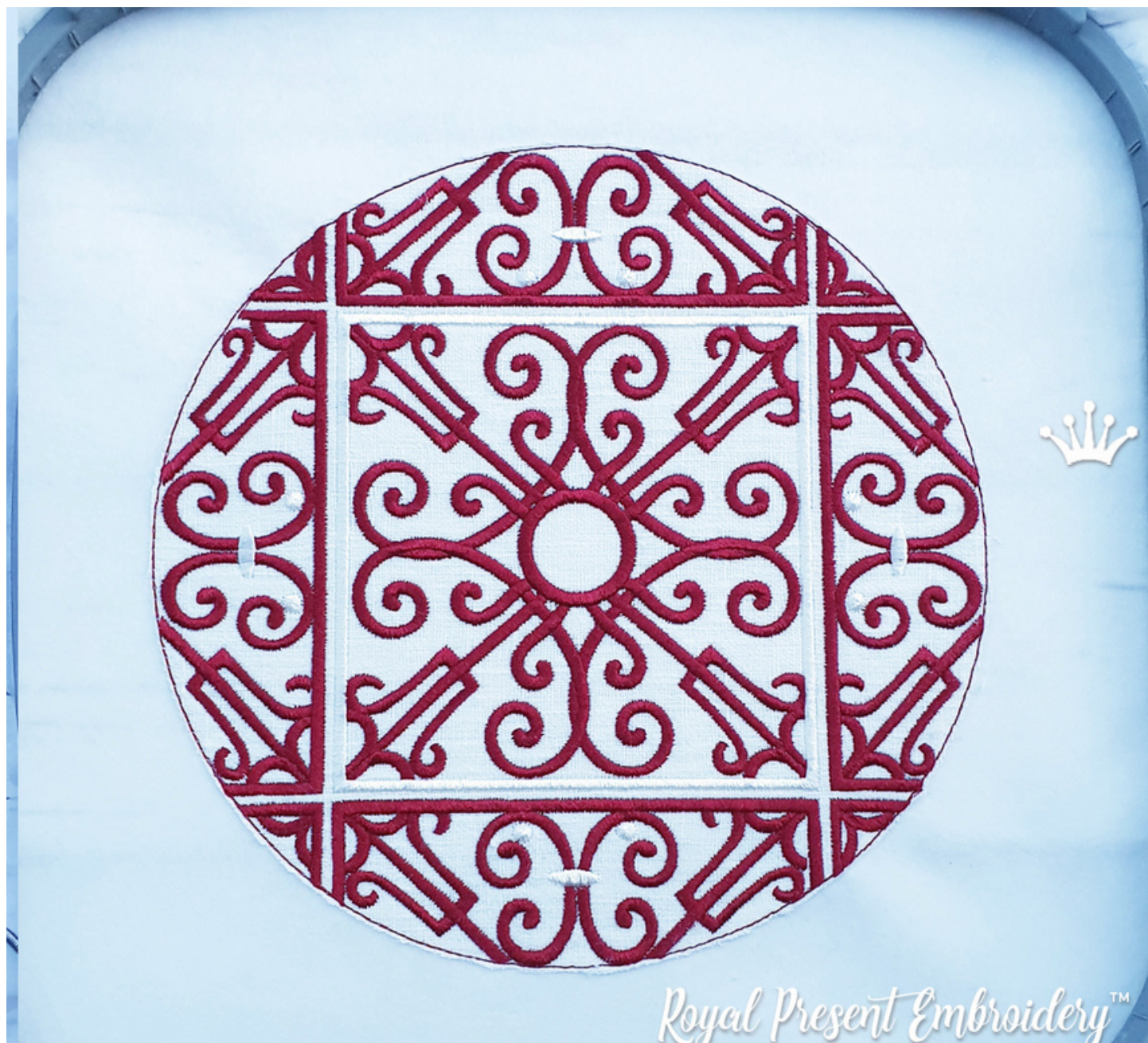

STAGE 5

6. Trim the fabric close to the outline on both sides.
