PLACEMAT ITH MACHINE EMBROIDERY DESIGN



HOW TO CREATE, A STEP-BY-STEP PROCESS

You will receive a finished product when you purchase this placemat design, which is embroidered directly in the hoop.


Before making the Placemat, it is recommended that you pre-wash the fabric.

1. Take a tear-off stabilizer in 2 layers, spray temporary glue on top of it, and hooping fabric of the color that you want to see as an edging on the Placemat.



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- 2. When the machine has sewn the outline, stop the machine.
- 3. You need to cut the fabric from the inside. Be careful not to damage the stabilizer.



The stitching should remain outside, as in our photo



4. Place a piece of fabric on this circle, the middle of the plate stand. Pre-spray the material with temporary adhesive.



5. Return the hoop to the machine, which will stitch this fabric to the napkin.



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6. Trim the fabric close to the outline



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7. Return the hoop to the machine, and it will embroider a satin outline.



8. Place the fabric under the hoop if you want your napkin to have a clean back. If you don't want to do this, skip this step.



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9. Turn on the machine; the machine will stitch the outline. Remove the hoop from the machine and trim the fabric close to the outline.



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If you made the fabric on the wrong side, trim it close to the outline.



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Return the hoop to the machine and finish embroidering. Tear off excess stabilizer



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Return the hoop to the machine and finish embroidering. Tear off the excess stabilizer.

The Placemat is ready.



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
