STAINED GLASS SANTA PLACEMAT MACHINE EMBROIDERY DESIGN IN 4 SIZES



HOW TO CREATE, A STEP-BY-STEP PROCESS

This instruction is suitable for all our placemats.

- 1. To prepare the fabric for embroidery, use temporary adhesive to attach two layers of stabilizer to it. Once this is done, place the fabric with the stabilizers into the embroidery hoop.
- 2. Embroider the design. Before the machine is to embroider an outline, stop the machine. Remove the hoop from the machine.
- 3. Turn the hoop over and spray the stabilizer from the wrong side with temporary fixation glue.
- 4. To create the back of the napkin, place a piece of fabric underneath the hoop, i.e., from the inside out. This will be the back of the napkin.
- 5. You should get it as in the photo.

- 6. Return the hoop to the machine and continue embroidering. The machine will embroider the outline. On our color chart, it is green. Embroider it in the color of your fabric.
- 7. Remove the hoop from the machine again



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- 8. Trim the fabric close to the outline on both sides. You should get it as in our photo.
- 9. Return the hoop to the machine, and finish the embroidery. Tear off the excess stabilizer.
